- Transport between visits in Cuba is provided.
- Guests are advised to make their own travel arrangements to arrive in Havana on 23 September in time for dinner on the same evening.
- The last event on the programme will take place on the evening of 27 September.
- Hotel check-out is scheduled for 28 September; guests should organise their return or onward travel arrangements accordingly.

- Places on this trip will be offered on a first-come basis as space is limited to 20 guests only.
- This trip will only take place if a minimum of 15 guests are confirmed.


